THIS DEED OF TRUST executed on this Seventh day of December Two Thousand and Four (7/12/2004) by the Archdiocese of Ernakulam-Angamally (In short hereinafter referred to as Archdiocese) a religious and charitable institution represented by its Present Vicar General, Mar Thomas Chakiath, Auxiliary Bishop, aged 67 (Sixty Seven) years, son of Mr. Chakappan, residing at Archbishop's house, Broadway, Ernakulam, Thrikkanarvattom Desom, Ernakulam Village, Kanyannoor Taluk, Ernakulam District, Kerala State, hereinafter referred to as the **SETTLER**.

IN FAVOUR OF, Rev. Fr. Antony Punnassery, the present Chancellor, aged 61 (Sixty one) years, son of Mr. Eyyob, Priest, residing at Archbishop's house, Broadway, Ernakulam, Thrikkanarvattom Desom, Ernakulam Village, Kanyannoor Taluk, Ernakulam District, Kerala State, hereinafter referred to as the **TRUSTEE OF THE TRUST**.

WHEREAS, the Settler institution was established in 1896 to undertake the religious and charitable activities envisaged by the Catholic Church, in the geographical area allotted to it and to administer the laity and the Priest and the institutions coming under its Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction.

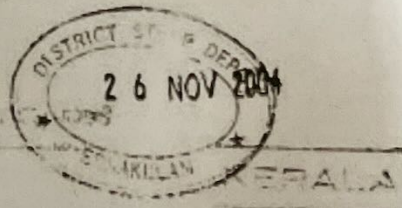

AND WHEREAS as part of the their educational apostolate, the Settler institution has established well reputed educational institutions from time to time including the famous Bharata Mata College Thrikkakara, St.Xavier's College Kothavara etc.

AND WHEREAS the Curia of the Settlers found that now it is the need of the time for the Diocese to enter into the Management Education Field, by starting with MBA Course.

AND WHEREAS now it is felt better to register an educational charitable trust for conducting the above Management School in a systematic and effective manner with perpetuity as an institution of the minority community upholding the rights and privileges given under the Constitution of India for such institutions, and for that purpose the Diocesan Curia of the Settler Diocese in its meeting held on 1st December 2004 has authorised Mar Thomas Chakiath, the Auxillary Bishop, the Vicar General to execute the Deed with the following terms and conditions in favour of Rev. Fr. Antony Punnassery and to get it registered.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH:-

- 1) **NAME OF THE TRUST:-** The Name of the Trust shall be

BHARATA MATA COLLEGE EDUCATIONAL TRUST - ERNAKULAM

- 2) **REGISTERED OFFICE:-**


The Registered Office of the Trust shall be at Ernakulam in Ernakulam District. The Trustees are at liberty to change the registered office to anywhere else in Kerala in the ecclesiastical jurisdiction of the Archdiocese of Ernakulam-Angamaly with the approval of the Settler.

- 3) **TRUST PROPERTY:-**


In order to effectuate the above referred decision, the Settler has made over to the Trustee a sum of Rs 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) to hold the same together with all additions and accretions thereto and all other property that may be acquired by purchase, lease, gift or otherwise and may herein after be the subject matter of the Trust (hereinafter called the Trust Fund) for the objects and on the terms and conditions herein contained concerning the same for the objects of the Trust.

- 4) **OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:-**

The main object of the Trust is to render educational service to the pupils irrespective of caste, creed and community and that too solely for philanthropic purposes and not for purposes of profit and such object shall inter-alia include:-
